On July 28, 2026, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received planning material with your letter dated July 28, 2026 for the as-built pressure filters for iron and manganese removal. Based on our review of the information submitted, the project generally meets the minimum requirements of Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 290 - Rules and Regulations for Public Water Systems and is **approved for use**.

The submittal consisted of 3 sheets of engineering drawings, annotated color photographs, and technical specifications. The approved project consists of:

- Three (3) 264-gallon each pressure filters in parallel with maximum loading rate of 5 gallons per minute per square feet (gpm/ft²), each consisting of:
 - Pentair Water Model PT3672-N-6, NSF 61 certified composite filter ASME pressure vessel;
 - NSF 61 certified Turbidex™ filter media;
 - Supporting gravel; and
 - Associated valves, fittings and appurtenances.

This approval is for use of the above listed items only. Any wastewater components contained in this design were not considered. The authorization provided in this letter does not relieve a Public Water System from the need to comply with other applicable state and federal regulations.

This project may have approved the construction of facilities that may require either the creation of or update to an Emergency Preparedness Plan (EPP). Information on EPPs is available at the following website:

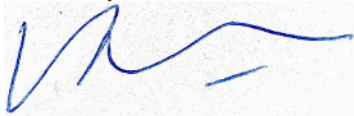
